

# Taekwondo packs in all the family

FRANCIS Habib has taught more than 3000 students in 23 years at his taekwondo school in Narwee.

The school, which has operated from the same hall at Narwee Public School for more than two decades, has seen entire families coming through its ranks.

"We're a very family-oriented club and we've had parents and their children do our courses at the same time," Mr Habib said. Parents brought their children along and then joined in, rather than just watching.

During the past eight years, Mr Habib has noticed that more girls and women have been participating in the classes.
